Roles & Responsibilities

ROLE:

- To conduct different fire drills, squad drill, parade & rescue exercise regularly for the students of B Tech (Fire & EHS) & B Sc. – Fire & Safety followed by evaluation of the students' performance.
- To submit periodical reports to the management as per the requirements.
- To maintain strict discipline among the students by providing effective leadership, mentoring & coaching in order to achieve the set objectives.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- To develop guidelines, procedures and rules & regulations.
- To demonstrate and train students for firefighting & rescue techniques.
- To impart rigorous training in use of different firefighting branches, hoses, coupling, rescue tools, portable / stationary fire fighting pumps, fire vehicles, breathing apparatus etc.
- To train the students and make them competent enough in firefighting & rescue operation.
- To organize interactions with students periodically to discuss their strengths & weaknesses and advise them for further improvement.
- To conduct regular classroom lectures for the students as per the syllabus.
- To be able to communicate with students in English.
- To conduct tests/examinations as per the university rules & regulations.
- To develop the liaison with fire brigades and industrial fire officers to get benefits of their facilities for specialised training to the students.
